## TAUP Executive Committee Opening

TAUP members:

Nominations are being sought for a special election to fill the seat of a TAUP Executive Committee member who has left Temple University. The term will start immediately upon election and will continue until April 30, 2013. To be eligible, you must be a dues-paying member of TAUP.

The TAUP Executive Committee is the decision-making body of the union and is responsible for the negotiation, implementation and supervision of the terms of the contract, which cover the conditions of employment for full-time faculty and staff. It sets policy for the union, oversees the union's financial and legal affairs, and is involved in negotiations between TAUP and the Temple administration

The EC has 15 elected members, plus three elected TAUP officers, and meets monthly for two to three hours. EC members are also asked to help out on various union activities between meetings, including being available to participate in online discussions and vote on urgent matters.
